

Procedure for possible registration of secondary intakes (neveninstromers) at De Klipper

Students who have already started at a primary school and, for whatever reason, want to switch to another primary school are called 'neveninstromers'. Because a change of school is often a difficult decision (not in the least for the student him/herself), a careful procedure is involved. This procedure is as follows:

First you will express your interest in De Klipper. To ensure that you get a good picture of our school and our education, an appointment will be made with you for a tour. In general, this will be at one of our guided tours with a group of parent at a 'groepsrondleidingochtend'.

After this tour, we would like to know if you want to register your child at De Klipper. Let us know either way by notify Chantel (our management support) at c.kralingen@daltondeklipper.nl .

If you have indicated that you want to register your child, the 'intern begeleiders' of De Klipper will contact your child's current school. Because your child is already in education, the current school can provide a lot of information. This gives us insight in the educational needs of your child and to determine whether we can meet those educational needs. If necessary the 'intern begeleider' will also contact parents.

Once all information had been collected there will be a consultation between intern begeleiders and management whether we can place your child at De Klipper.

The 'intern begeleider' will contact you about the decision of the school.

According to the national government, primary schools have 6 weeks to collect the correct information to determine whether their school is a suitable place for a student. The 6 weeks may, if necessary, be extended by 4 weeks.
